God has a plan and a purpose for my life:

In reply Jesus said: "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he fell into the hands of robbers. They stripped him of His clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half-dead.

Luke 10:30

- * Do you really believe God has a plan and purpose for your life? Jeremiah 29:11
- * God says what He means and means what He says, do we? Numbers 23:19
- * Do I really want to be free from my suffering and am I willing to take part in the process? *Naaman: II Kings 5:8-14, Blind man: John 9:1-7*
- * Christ gives us life abundant. *"The thought of doing God's purpose for me only half-way brings feelings of remorse and the thought that if I am living half alive" spiritually it better be because I really am half dead" physically."*
